1. Guest speaker – Dave Holtz, La Crosse County Board Supervisor could not make the meeting as planned but the update is: house has new owner and they are cleaning up the property.
2. Guest speaker – Tim Acklin, Senior Planner, City of La Crosse Planning Dept. Tim discussed the Capital Improvement Funds and the process to submit requests to be considered for this fund. The deadline to submit is April 14 for the 2019 budget. He explained the types of improvements that would fall under this, such as: parks, street scaping, lighting, roads, curb/gutter, sidewalks, etc. In addition, Tim has been designated the contact person for our HNA. Doug Happel was also present.
3. Treasurer election did not take place. The process for nominations will start over next month.
4. Announcements / New business –
 - Asked everyone in attendance to have suggestions ready for the next meeting to discuss the improvement needs for the neighborhood as this is the last meeting before the deadline.
