### WINDOW/DOOR REPLACEMENT

#### Do I need a building permit?

Yes

#### How much will it cost?

\$125

#### How do I obtain a permit?

Email or drop-off to the Community Risk Management the following:

- Supply the window(s) size, door size(s), header size(s), a floor plan and a sectional drawing.
- Provide a copy of the manufacturer's specifications (if required).

#### Where can I put a dumpster?

Generally, the dumpster can be placed on your property. If placed on a public property or in the right-of-way/street a Dumpster Permit is required from the Engineering Department.

#### When must I call for inspections?

Inspections are required at the following times:

- After framing, but before windows/door is installed (if required)
- After insulating (if required)
- When the project is complete

#### Frequently encountered issues:

Following is a list of frequent problems or errors we encounter:

- No framing inspection (if required)
- No insulating inspection (if required)
- No final inspection

**NOTE:** If the home owner does not hire a contractor to perform work under the building permit that is bonded and insured, a Cautionary Statement must be signed and submitted with the application. (*SEE ATTACHED FORM*)

The property owner is responsible for correct placement of structures upon a parcel of land to comply with the building and zoning law. The back edge of the City sidewalk is usually located on a property line.

**CAUTIONARY STATEMENT TO OWNERS OBTAINING BUILDING PERMITS**

101.65(lr) of the Wisconsin Statutes requires municipalities that enforce the Uniform Dwelling Code to provide an owner who applies for a building permit with a statement advising the owner that:

If the owner hires a contractor to perform work under the building permit and the contractor is not bonded or insured as required under s. 101.654 (2) (a), the following consequences might occur:

(a) The owner may be held liable for any bodily injury to or death of others or for any damage to the property of others that arises out of the work performed under the building permit or that is caused by any negligence by the contractor that occurs in connection with the work performed under the building permit.

(b) The owner may not be able to collect from the contractor damages for any loss sustained by the owner because of a violation by the contractor of the one- and two- family dwelling code or an ordinance enacted under sub. (1) (a), because of any bodily injury to or death of others or damage to the property of others that arises out of the work performed under the building permit or because of any bodily injury to or death of others or damage to the property of others that is caused by any negligence by the contractor that occurs in connection with the work performed under the building permit.

**CAUTIONARY STATEMENT TO CONTRACTORS FOR PROJECTS INVOLVING BUILDING BUILT BEFORE 1978**

If this project is in a dwelling or child-occupied facility, built before 1978, and disturbs 6 sq. ft. or more of paint per room, 20 sq. ft. or more of exterior paint, or involves windows, then the requirements of ch. DHS 163 requiring Lead-Safe Renovation Training and Certification apply. **WETLANDS NOTICE TO PERMIT APPLICANTS**
