Agenda:

1. We reviewed our Neighborhood Action Plan so we can update for 2019.
 - a. Increase Membership: We did get some yard signs and we will distribute in spring when the snow is gone. We will be doing a mailing in March that will include a notice on the Capital Improvement Funds. Our new updated website aligned to LCNI is www.lacrosseneighborhoods.org/hintgen. A suggestion was made to push out our boundaries to expand into other neighborhoods. We will continue to discuss this more later in the year.
 - b. Safety Committee – Dave and Steve will get together to discuss in more detail areas of concern and bring back to the large group.
 - c. Highland Park – Dee Dee will get more details on what we will be able to place in the park so suggestions can be brought back to the large group.
 - d. Problem with semi trucks in the neighborhood: This will be removed for the 2019 Plan as we have seen improvements in this area.
 - e. Dates will be updated on all sections.
2. The March Capital Improvement Funds was discussed as we were awarded money from the Mayor. Linda and Sue are working with Tim Aklin from the city regarding this fund. The annual mailing will address this so the news can get out to everyone in the HNA boundary. We will work on the mailing coming up with a few suggestions so that it can be discussed and approved during the February meeting. Our March meeting will be a long one and the start time may have to be adjusted accordingly. Watch for any announce at the February meeting.
3. We selected a few dates for possible fundraisers in May and Sue B will see if we can secure one or both of them for the Brat Barn.
4. Dave S gave us the Treasurer's update and there has been no change to our fund since November's meeting.
5. The Social Committee is looking at August for our annual event.
