



05/20/19 Minutes

Meeting started at 6:30 and adjourned at 7:35

Attendance: 9 + 1 guest

1. Sue reported that the LCNI bill for our insurance came in. The treasurer report was at \$574.62 and now less the \$167.00, new balance will be \$407.62.
2. Planting of boulevard trees was discussed; the City said they would assess the area, where they would want them, etc. A letter would go out to those residences (first) to see if they would want and be willing to take care of a tree on their boulevard. The Association would have to decide how much of the Capitol Improvement Fund we would like to use for trees. Sue will contact Dan Trussoni from the City of La Crosse Parks Dept for more detailed information. It was first reported that we may be looking at 300 trees but a correction is that each tree costs \$300.
3. Lighting on 25th, 26th, and 27th streets was discussed briefly. One attendee said she felt the lighting was just fine on 27th St. Another said that the city came out and the lighting is within the city guidelines. We will circle back around to this at a later meeting.
4. We need volunteers to work the Brat Barn at the Village Festival on June 1st from 10:00 for set up to 2:00 or portions of those times. We are doing this as a fund raiser for our HNA. We had two people at the meeting volunteer. More are needed.
5. Denise reported on the updates from the Parks committee. She presented a survey along with some examples to be put on our website to see what the area residence would like to see put in at the Highland Park. In addition a post card to be mailed out was designed to let everyone know about the survey. It was decided by the Co-Chairs that we will do a post card to tell everyone to come to the September 16th meeting (Tentative date as this has not been scheduled yet with Dan Trussoni) but we will not do a survey. A presentation would be made by the city with two options. A vote would be taken at that meeting. The postcard will also have a link to the options so people can preview them if they wish. Residence can be heard at that time. You must attend 2 meetings per 12 months in order to vote. The committee will meet again to decide on the two options to be presented.
