02/10/20 Minutes

Meeting started at 6:30 and adjourned at 7:45

Attendance: 5 and 2 guest

1. The minutes from last month were approved
2. There was no treasurer's report, she was not present.
3. Doug Happel, Dist. 12 council member, asked us to announce that the Senior Center is researching a move to St Andrew St., any comments or concerns please contact him at 788-1185.
4. Our first speaker was Community Policing Officer Dustin Darling. There were three areas that he touched on:
 - a. The installation of the needle disposal box by Walgreens at the corner of Losey and Mormon Coulee and also the importance of calling the non-emergency police number if needles are found on the ground. The Fire Dept. or Police Dept. will come out to remove.
 - b. A new program that is in the works to potentially roll out called "Good Neighbor Project" which is very similar to the old neighborhood watch program. The importance of bridging communications between residents and police, keeping an eye out in your neighborhood for suspicious activity and calling into the non-emergency number. The police cannot be everywhere so with the tips or data they receive they update their information and then know what to look for when they are going through the neighborhoods. The type of information to report would be license numbers, description of vehicles or people, dates and times, etc.
 - c. The Police Dept is asking businesses and residents that have security cameras to contact them so they can get a good data base of where cameras are in case of an incident in the vicinity.
5. Our second speaker was Jamie Hassemen, Civil Engineer with the City of La Crosse. Jamie had a presentation regarding city street lighting and city pedestrian lighting and the guidelines they follow. This is an area on our Goals and Objectives so we are trying to learn more about how it all works. He pointed out some areas to check out such as 5th through 7th Streets and also a new area they did around Logan Middle School. We will continue to look further into this however, adding a few street lights on 25th, 26th and 27th cannot be done.
