### Late Fee Calculation

Late Payment Charges: If a payment is not received within 20 days of the billing date, a late payment charge of 1% per month will be applied to the unpaid balance, including unpaid late payment charges.

#### *Bulk Water Charges*

Truck Fills	\$30.00 one time service charge + \$1.05 per 100 Cu.Ft. volume charge
Metered Bulk Water	\$30.00 one time service charge + \$1.05 per 100 Cu.Ft. volume charge a) A minimum volume charge may apply as approved by the PSC. b) If the meter is assigned to or not returned by a customer within 30 days, the applicable Fixed Service Charge from above will apply on a pro-rated basis after the first 30 days. <b>(NOTE: Customer bears all risk of loss or damage and is responsible for any replacement/repair costs of a meter. )</b>

Water Rates are established for the Water Utility by the Public Service Commission (PSC) of Wisconsin. The rates should be high enough to provide the utility with a reasonable opportunity to recover the total costs of providing service and to sustain its financial integrity that in turn provides a dependable and reliable service to the consumer.
